*The patient's past medical history has been remarkably insignificant with only a 40 pound weight gain in the past three days.*

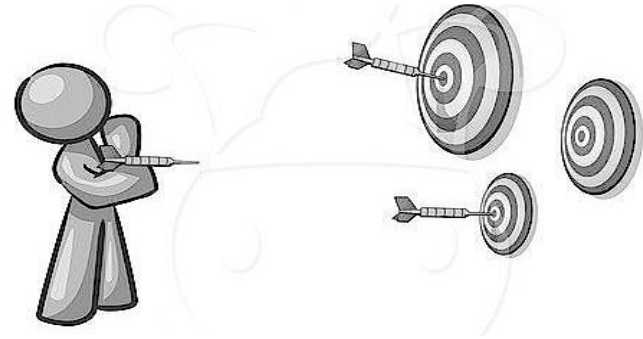
She slipped on the ice and apparently her legs went in separate directions in early December.
