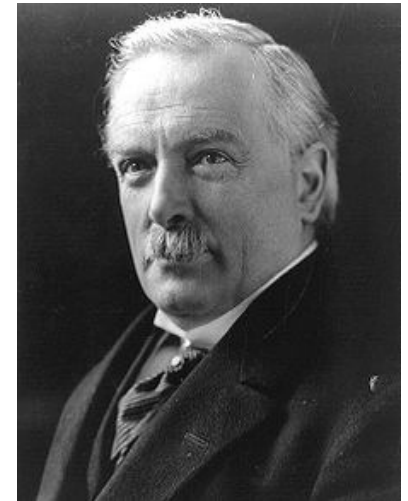
## March 2011
